I would therefore be very grateful if you could ensure your child is in school as much as possible during the forthcoming year as this gives them the best chance of success.

Could I also ask you to make sure that your child arrives on time.

School starts at 8.55am and our playground gates are locked promptly at this time. The gates from the Green are locked promptly at 9.00am.

After these times, the only way to access the building is via the main office.

Can I also remind you that we no longer authorise absence for 'normal' family holidays.

Leave of absence will only be authorised in exceptional circumstances such as :

- Family weddings.
- Family Funerals
- Prison visits.

Please be aware that when leave of absence is not authorised and parents /carers still take their child out of school, this may result in Penalty Notices being issued and further involvement by the Educational Welfare Service.

The cost of Penalty Notice is currently £120 to be paid within 28 days. The cost reduces to £60 if paid within 21 days. (Where 2 parents are issued with penalty Notices for the same child, the fine will apply to both parents and the cost doubles)
